



Pre-Operative Instructions

- No Food after 8pm the night before surgery.
- Water is ok until the morning of surgery.
- Please drop off your pet between 9am-10am the day his/her surgery is scheduled.
- Please bring any current blood work and/or radiographs from your regular veterinarian.
- Please bring all of your pet's prescribed medications with you on the day of surgery.
- Unless otherwise instructed by the surgery staff, please give regular medications, as directed, by prescribing veterinarian.
- If your pet is a diabetic, please call for specific food and insulin instructions!
- If your pet is on a special diet or would like them to only receive a certain brand of food, feel free to bring their food, clearly marked with their name and quantity to be served daily.
 - Unless the veterinarian deems it necessary to change your pet's diet due to medical reasons, he/she will be sure to receive your specified diet plan.
- Please refrain from bringing toys, blankets or bones.
 - We provide clean bedding and toys for each patient and often their bedding is changed several times a day. Personal toys and bedding are often mixed up in the wash and we do not wish to misplace precious items due to frequent bedding changes. We guarantee soft, comfortable, clean bedding for each patient.
- Please call or e-mail the surgery department with any questions regarding your pet's upcoming procedure. We would be happy to answer any questions you may have.
